The sugar was kept in big warehouses in Port Louis and formed into large pyramids. It was then exported to many countries.

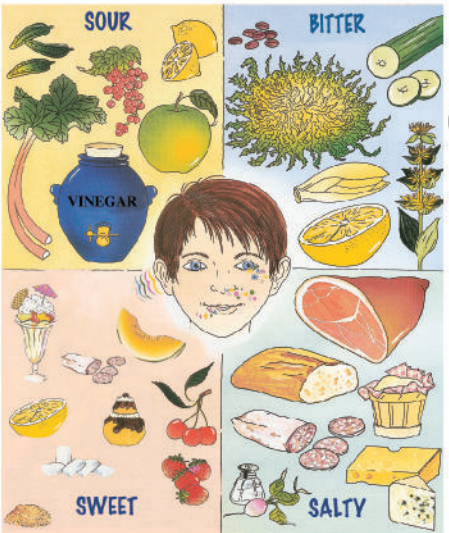

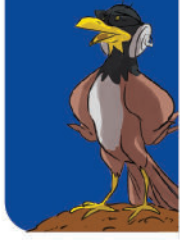
Look for the king of Corsairs: Robert Surcouf

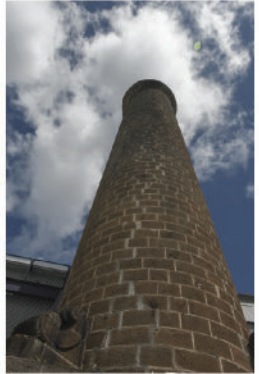
Find the stone chimney of our sugar factory.
