The sugar was kept in big warehouses in Port Louis and formed into large pyramids. It was then exported to many countries.








Now let's go discover the sweet flavour.

Find the poster of the 4 tastes. Raj and Florise prefer the sweet one. Which do you prefer?




Circle the two food items that don't belong in the sweet corner.


